Freeway Lace Guild Minutes of Dec 7, 2019

Meeting was called to order at 10:30 AM by Sylvia Fellows with Maria Provencher volunteering to take the minutes.

Mr. Bill is having several issues related to Health, Fridge, and his washer. Send him a quick note if you can.

Treasurer Report: Louise R. our treasurer accidently used the Debit Card of the Freeway lace guild for personal use in the amount of \$25 and is replacing that with a personal check. Additionally she used her personal card to pay for the lunches at Lace day in the amount of \$252.25 so she need to be paid for the this. A motion was made by Francesca and Seconded by Susan Trezek that we write a check for \$252.25 to cover the lunch. Motion carried unanimously. We made \$575.20 on Lace Day in large part because of the consignment donations and there is a \$45 left to deposit. Balance in our account is \$9,156,69.

It was moved by Francesca and seconded by Caitlyn that we give one month's rent donation to the Church as we have done in the past. The motion carried unanimously. We embraced our diversity of Religions and it was suggested that we make a design for a piece of lace that includes all of our religious symbols.

Website Report: Caitlyn Ference-Saunders is our new Website person and the website is now built but private for now and we need to get the transfer of the name to the new site and that is being worked on. Caitlyn asked that in January we bring our favorite lace pieces for photographing so that we can add them to the website if we like. Caitlyn's husband will bring a good camera for photos and we would also like to photograph the officers. In addition Past Presidents will be included and if not living locally can send in a photo. Caitlyn made a motion that we adopt a new website with a \$140 starting fee per year and we may need to pay more for the domain in the amount of \$10-\$20 so that the domain can be transferred. The meeting was adjourned at 11;20 with a motion by Susan Trezek and a second by Rose. We reopened the meeting at 11:35 to form a nominating committee for Officers for the years 2020 and 2021. The Vote will take place at the January meeting. Sylvia Fellows appointed Maria Provencher, Susan Trezek, and Rose WIlson to be the committee. The meeting was re adjourned at 11:45.
