Sharon Mitchell - lace tree, Idrija ornament

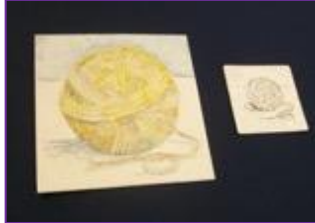

9 pair bobbins-Danish or plain (there are many sewings)
Size thread - tating 80???? or Idrija 30 - med leaf; Metallic thread Gutterman or metler 40
Guterman silk 100/3 or Metler 50 -small leaf
Weavers 2 pr. - 3 yds each bobbin- 2 metallic pair (optional)passives 2 yds each bobbin.
Julia will have patterns and hints.

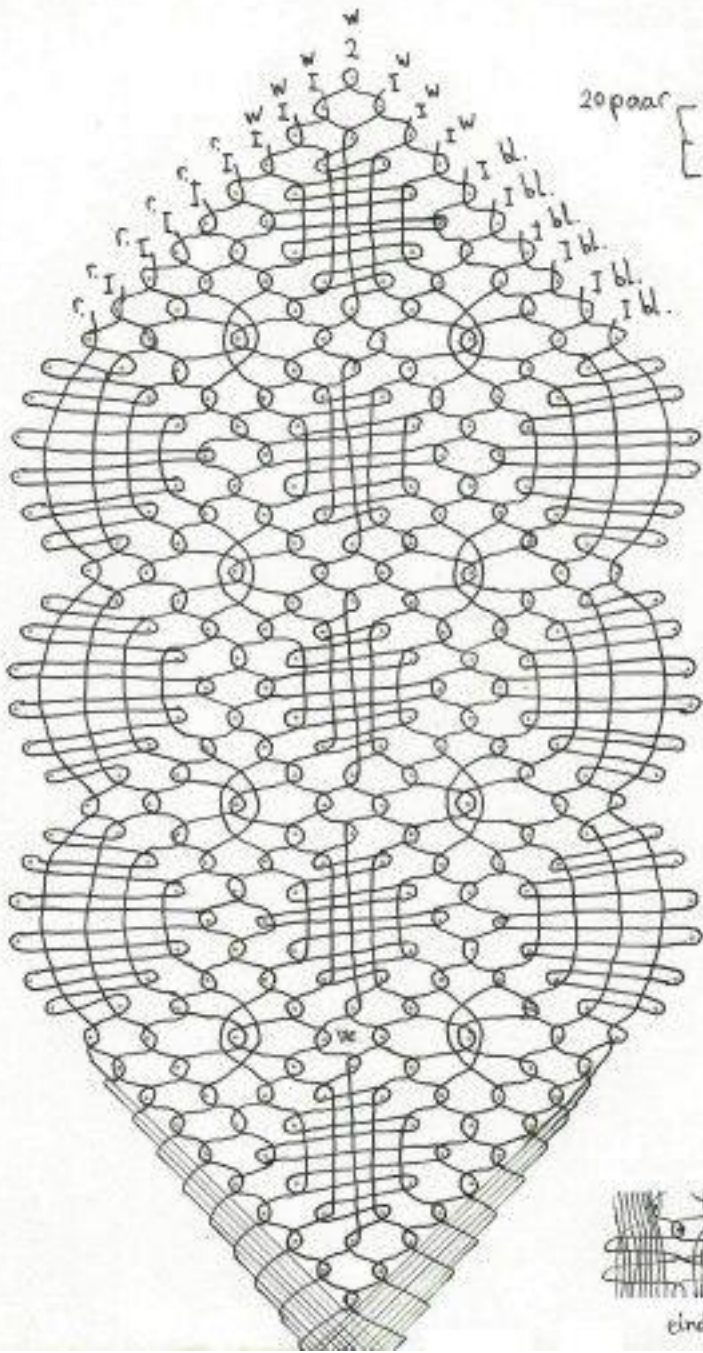
